

BASE LANTERN INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS MODEL NO. 7982-21

Congratulations on your purchase of a Newport Coastal 'Base Lantern'. You have purchased a safe, dependable, and easy-to-install outdoor, post lighting system. You can use this fixture at home for outdoor post lighting applications

WHAT'S INCLUDED: A - Post Collar

B - Wire Connector (3)

C - 4-1/4" Fixture Mounting Screws (3)

D - Fixture Lid

F - Louvers (2)

H - Nut Caps (3)

Required: Phillips Screwdriver, 3" Diameter Lamp Post, Silicon Sealant or Caulk, Drill

E - Set Screw (1)

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

THIS PRODUCT MUST BE INSTALLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL APPLICABLE INSTALLATION CODES.

- IF YOU ARE NOT FAMILIAR WITH ELECTRICAL WIRING, IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOU SECURE THE SERVICES OF A WELL QUALIFIED ELECTRICIAN WHO CAN ASSURE THAT THIS INSTALLATION MEETS LOCAL, STATE, AND NATIONAL CODES.
- BE SURE POWER IS TURNED OFF AT THE MAIN POWER PANEL OR FUSE BOX PRIOR TO INSTALLATION OR REPLACING FIXTURE.
- Before installing this fixture, be sure to check with local ordinances regarding approved outdoor lighting. This fixture style may not be allowed in some areas.
- This fixture is for outdoor use only.
- Do not install on a post or pole that results in a vertical rise of 25 feet or higher. Suitable for mounting within 4 feet of the ground.
- Apply a weatherproof silicon sealant or caulk around the fixture base after installation.
- The electrical system and the method of connecting the fixture to the system must be in accordance with local, state, and national electric codes. This fixture is to be connected to a 120 volt, 60 Hz power source. Connecting to a different power source may create a hazard and will void the warranty.
- This fixture is suitable for wet locations.
- Do not use near or around flammable/combustible material or liquids.

 When replacing the lamp (bulb), use only Type A medium base lamp (bulb) 60 Watt Maximum. Never use a lamp (bulb) with a higher wattage than the stated maximum allowed on the fixture. Using a higher wattage lamp may cause a fire hazard and/or damage to the unit.
- The lamp (bulb) and fixture can get hot during use. Turn off the power and allow the fixture to cool down for at least 10 minutes prior to working on the unit.

PRIOR TO INSTALLATION - Carefully read through the entire installation instructions before installing this fixture.




INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

BE SURE POWER IS TURNED OFF AT THE MAIN POWER PANEL OR FUSE BOX PRIOR TO INSTALLATION OR REPLACING FIXTURE.

- Remove old lighting fixture. If installing at a new location, contact a qualified electrician.
- Pull the supply wires from the lamp post. If installing new lamp post with this product, please refer to instructions included with post for proper installation procedure.
- WIRING See Figure 1
- Connect the Black wire from the base of Post Collar (A) to Black wire of the supply circuit using Wire Connector (B).
- Connect the White wire from the base of Post Collar (A) to White wire of the supply circuit using Wire Connectors (B) Connect bare fixture ground wire to ground wire from supply circuit using Wire Connectors (B).

NEVER CONNECT GROUND WIRE TO BLACK OR WHITE POWER SUPPLY WIRES.





- Position Post Collar (A) over the lamp post, carefully inserting wires into the post.
 Fasten with Set Screw (E) at hole in Post Collar (A) by a drilling 1/8" diameter pilot hole at same location (Figure 2) through post. Insert and tighten screw with Phillips screwdriver.
- Position Louvers (F) onto Post Collar (A) by inserting mounting posts on Post Collar and Louvers (F) into holes as provided - Figure 3.
- Install Type A Medium Base lamp (bulb not included)) into socket housing. Lamp wattage NOT to exceed 60 Watts. See 'Installing or Replacing Lamp' Section for installation details.
- Insert Diffuser (G) by placing open end into Post Collar (A) base.
 Place Fixture Lid (D) on top of Diffuser (G) and secure using 4-1/4" Mounting Screws (C) and Nut Caps (H). See Figure 4.

INSTALLING OR REPLACING LAMPS


- WARNING: Turn off the power and allow the fixture to cool down for at least 10 minutes prior to working on the unit.
- Remove Fixture Lid (D) by removing 4-1/4" mounting screws (C) and Nut Caps (H), then lifting off Diffuser (G).
- Install Type A Medium Base lamp (bulb not included)) into socket housing. Lamp wattage NOT to exceed 60 Watts.

 To remove existing lamp (bulb) gently twist lamp counterclockwise until it becomes free of fixture. Install new lamp (bulb) by turning clockwise. Do not over-tighten lamp (bulb).
- Re-attached Fixture Lid (D).

TROUBLESHOOTING

Does not function at all

- Make sure wall switch (if applicable) is ON and that the wiring is correct.
- Check that the circuit breaker, fuse, and main circuit breaker or main power switch are ON.
- Check other accessories (photo sensor, convenience outlet, etc.) to make sure they have been installed properly.
